* FEAST OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST (Vespers on Sunday at 1:15 PM / Liturgy, Mon., at 9:30 AM):

On August 29 each year we commemorate the death of St. John the Baptist. About him our Savior Jesus Christ said: Amen, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist... St. Justin of Serbia preached the following: "The Holy Forerunner appeared in death's kingdom as the first Evangelist, in order to preach the Good News of Christ to all of the souls in the kingdom of death. He appeared as well to all of them as the first Martyr, to show that people will joyously go to their deaths for True God, the Lord Jesus Christ, Savior of the world, until death is defeated and destroyed. They will not fear death, for they will be more powerful than death. Through His bodily Resurrection, the Lord grants the body victory over death. ... Brothers and sisters, whenever you are in great sorrow, turn to that first Apostle of Christ, and he will help you with all of your burdens. And should some kind of misfortune happen, turn to that first Evangelist. No matter what bitterness might fill your soul, he will sweeten it with Christ's grace, which he will mystically send down to your tortured soul from the World on High. And when you find yourself in temptations and horrors of this earthly life, run to him, to the Holy Confessor; tell him what is in your heart, pour out your sorrows and spiritual needs and rest assured that in a mystical, divine manner, he will come down into your soul and will save you, and will deliver you from all temptations and woes." This particular feast day is observed with abstinence from meat and dairy products all day. We fast strictly (eating and drinking nothing) until about 3 PM. It is, or perhaps was, customary in the Carpatho-Russian custom to eat without using a plate on this day, in remembrance of how the precious head of St. John was brought to Herod and the revelers.
